- 9. Insurance/Disability Coverage: Harvester must provide the following insurance documents.
 - a. Liability Insurance not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
 - b. Compliance with Workers' Compensation Law for Insurance and provide proper proof of coverage or exemption under law:
 - i. Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from NYS Workers'
 Compensation and/or Disability Coverage; or
 - ii. Certificate of Workers' Compensation Insurance; or
 - iii. Certificate of Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance
 - c. Compliance with Workers' Compensation Law regarding Disability Benefits
 - i. Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from NYS Workers'
 Compensation and/or Disability Benefits Coverage; or
 - ii. Certificate of Disability Benefits Insurance; or
 - iii. Certificate of Disability Benefits Self-Insurance

10. Surety.

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a. The Code Enforcement Officer shall require surety for performance in a form satisfactory to the Town by the harvester and/or property owner for a minimum amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00). Any harvesting of timbers for more than a fifty (50) acre area will require surety in the amount of

Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per acre. The maximum amount of any such surety shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). The purpose of the surety is to ensure compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance. Upon completion of harvesting activities, and compliance with all provisions of local law, as certified by a written statement from the Code Enforcement Officer, the security shall be returned. In the case of noncompliance with this Ordinance, the Town Board shall utilize the security or such portion thereof as may be necessary to ameliorate such noncompliance.

- 11. Registration Fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) required.
- 12. Complete State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR).
- 13. The property owner or harvester is to secure all permits required by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, New York State Department of Transportation, Chemung County, Town of Ashland, and/or other agencies of jurisdiction. I also acknowledge receipt and compliance with the Town of Ashland Timber Harvesting Local Law #1 of 1995 and Amendments.
